Saturday October 25 and Sunday October 26, 2008, noon-5pm

PROMOTIONAL MATERIALS: All participating, registered artists will receive bulk quantities of promotional materials including postcards (late September) and brochures (late September) listing artists' names and venues to distribute to your mailing lists. The success of the event depends upon drawing in viewers, much of which is in response to artists mailing these materials.

DORCHESTERARTISTS.ORG: DAC is continuing to upgrade the website and will use this site to attract additional visitors to Open Studios. Registered artists will be listed on the website. If you want an image of your work to be posted on the site, send a PDF or JPEG to donna@krausedesigninc.com. Please include the name of the piece, medium, and your name and contact information. There is no fee for this. You can also upload your own images by going to www.thedac.org and becoming a member which is currently free. Once a member, you can follow the links to add images to your "gallery" space online.

GROUP SITE EXHIBITORS: If you are exhibiting at FPC or TBH, you will be provided a space approximately 8' x 8'. You must assume that there will be no wall space on which to mount art. You will be responsible for developing a booth in which your work can be displayed to its best advantage using freestanding structures. Tables and chairs, and access to electricity for which you will need to provide extension cords and lights are available.

Finally, floorplans of site assignments at group sites will be made available to you on or about September 10.
